We have a great mixture of returning guards and new faces on the staff this year. I am still learning about all of them, but in the short time we have been a staff, they have impressed me with their hard work and positive character. I think you will all be pleased by the great staff that has been assembled both on the pool deck and in the snack bar.

Most of the pool rules have remained the same but I wanted to list a few reminders:

- * In order to leave your child at the pool unattended or for them to jump off the diving board, they must have passed the swim test. You can approach a guard or manager to administer the test when your child is ready.
- * Please take note of our pool hours (especially before school is out for the summer), and promptly pick your kids up at closing time (7 p.m. on most nights). Kids left afterhours will wait for their parents in the lobby of the clubhouse.
- * In regards to weather closings, any time there is lightning or thunder the pool will be cleared. If it is dangerously close, the pool deck will be cleared and closed for safety reasons. In the case of cold weather, rain, and cloudiness; the manager on duty will use his discretion, in regards to opening. In these first few weeks, the water temperature will be a key factor in the decision making process. Please call the clubhouse to inquire on pool openings.

I hope everyone has a great summer at the pool, and we will do our best to create a safe, clean, relaxed, and fun atmosphere.
